What is the European Diploma for Orthoptists?

The OCE has recognised that the orthoptic training across Europe varies in duration, competency level and knowledge required. To harmonise orthoptic training, eight European Higher Education institutions together with the OCE education committee applied and successfully obtained an Erasmus grant to develop a European diploma for orthoptists (EDORTH). This project has involved conducting a survey evaluating the current orthoptic training across Europe, develop a standardised European Competency Profile for Orthoptists and produce an online theoretical course which includes a final examination. Successfully studying this course and passing the exam will allow you to obtain a European Diploma for Orthoptists.

Who can study the European Diploma for Orthoptists course?

This course is aimed at fully qualified orthoptists.

Why might this be of interest for you?

The European diploma for orthoptists course is an opportunity for you to ensure your knowledge is meeting the European Competency level. It may allow easier mobility if you wish to work in a different country in Europe.
